1. Introduction

The changes to the Financial Disclosure Management (FDM) application described herein were deployed to the Production environment on November 29, 2015. The modifications includes minor updates to the previously deployed OGE 278e filing form (FDM v7.0.2.2 deployed on September 20, 2015) to address bugs detected during the testing process and by users.

2. Version 7.0.2.2.4 Defects and Changes

2.1. JIRA FDM-688

It was determined that exporting the 278e in PDF format was a needed key feature of FDM. As part of this release an additional option for the users to export to PDF was added to the View/Print tab within the report. The format of the report remains identical to the html version initially developed.

Note the 278e View/Print option will only display for reports not completed before 21Sep15.

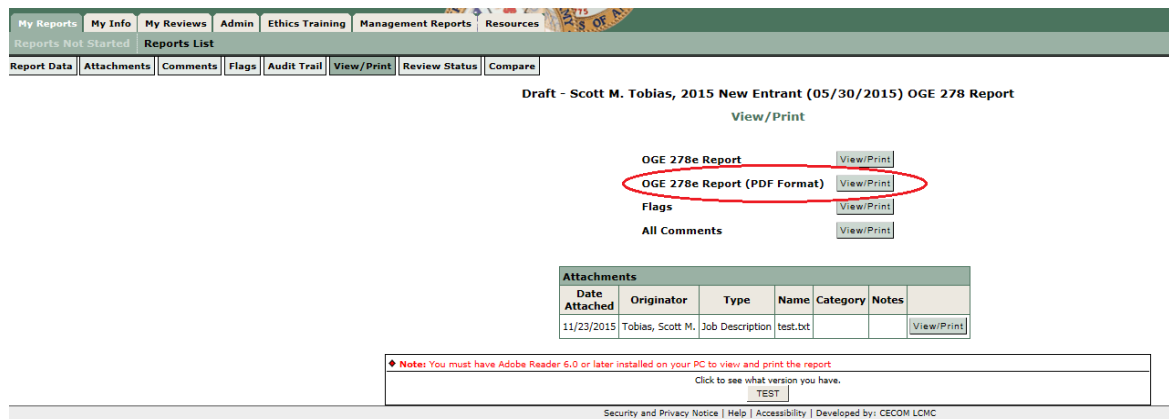


Figure 1 View/Print tab

2.2 JIRA FDM-687

The generic type used within the database to describe the Asset Type for assets created under the guidelines of the 278e was erroneously displaying when the user viewed the "Flags" for their report. The verbiage being displayed was "e278type" and was replaced by "N/A". The asset type is no longer applicable when dealing with the new 278e report types.

2.3 JIRA FDM-675

FDM allows the user to bypass input validation in certain areas of the Wizard. This issue relates specifically to when a user elects not to enter a City, State, and Country or any combination therein. The output form would place a comma incorrectly when City or State were missing causing two commas to be next to each other.

2.4 JIRA FDM-693

When a Military type filer files a New Entrant report they are prompted to enter their “60th Day on Active Duty”. The initial development of the 278e functionality didn’t display this value on the output report. As part of this release both the html and pdf versions of the report were updated to reflect this value.
