About FDM

Financial Disclosure Management (FDM) is an online tool that streamlines the financial disclosure reporting and review process. Its unique wizard design walks you through the form filling and review process.

FDM incorporates Office of Government Ethics (OGE) certified business rules, ensuring accurate financial disclosure filing.

FDM has taken measures to ensure that personal information is protected through security features such as encryption and user authentication.

FDM Announcements

- FDM in its 8th year of operation.
- Over 106,000 Confidential and Public Filers are registered and using FDM.
- Over 96,000 of the registered Filers are from DoD Agencies.
- 60% of entire DoD currently uses FDM.
- 25% of the Executive Branch uses FDM.
- Over 9,700 non-DoD registered Filers are using FDM
 - The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, over 8,000 filers
 - Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, Special Government Employees, 400 Filers

 - Access to financial disclosure report information is restricted to the members of a filer's review chain.
 - FDM establishes user identities through your agency's user directory or DoD Common Access Cards (CACs).

- **Accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through an Internet connection.**

Features

- An interviewing wizard that guides filers and reviewers through the financial disclosure reporting and reviewing process.
- Pre-population feature allows reuse of previous reports' data, avoiding re-entry.
- Automatic "flagging" of incomplete and/or inconsistent data as it is entered.
- E-mail alerts that allow for the management of filer and reviewer activity.
- Reviewers can see all of their filer's reports and their status at a glance.
- Side-by-side report comparison allows you to see the changes made to this year's disclosure report compared to last year's.
- A suite of management tools offering Agency-wide visibility.
- Audit trail that records all report activity.
- Role-based security restricts access to financial disclosure report information to the members of the Filer's review chain.
- Secure communication ensures that all personal information is protected through the use of encryption providing the highest level of protection possible when making confidential transactions over the Internet.
